Cadets and Parents, 11 June 2021

Encampment is getting a lot closer. Here's another update of minor issues that have come up over the past week as people have asked questions about encampment:

**Lunch** on the travel day: Whether the cadet is travelling on the 16<sup>th</sup> for ADVON or the 19<sup>th</sup> for Main Body, the schedule calls for them to arrive at Camp San Luis Obispo by Noon. We will have a sack lunch waiting for them. This doesn't preclude cadets bringing snacks on the bus, but the busses won't stop for meals, and masks are required while riding the bus, so no major eating will be possible.

**Graduation Ceremony**: If you're asking this, you haven't read the material posted on the website (I wonder what else you missed). The Cadet Commander talks extensively about graduation in her Welcome Letter. There is no public graduation for the Leadership Camp – we'll do that internally. We do invite you to the graduation at the end of Encampment on Sunday, 27 June, at 11:00. Please arrive by 10:00 – it takes a while to park, get onto base, and walk to the parade field; we don't want you to miss the ceremony.

Uniform for the Bus: Class C

If you haven't received the required uniforms from your school, don't worry. We'll issue the remainder when you arrive at CSLO.

**Covid Test**: Still must be within 3 days of travel. Keep proof of your test – a receipt, etc. If they won't give you a receipt, keep a copy of your appointment confirmation and take a photo of you getting the test. Bring whatever proof you have – ideally the results, but if not, something that shows you tested – to the bus. If you don't have your results before you board the bus, please forward them upon receipt to <a href="mailto:covid19@cacadets.org">covid19@cacadets.org</a>.

**Unit you're assigned to**: If you haven't checked your assignment, it's listed on the roster on the Encampment Website: https://cacadets.org/Events/SummerEncampment titled Leadership Session Roster and Advanced Session Roster.

**Bus Pick-Up**: The bus roster is also on the Encampment Website: <a href="https://cacadets.org/Events/SummerEncampment">https://cacadets.org/Events/SummerEncampment</a>, titled ADVON Transportation Plan (for those travelling on June 16<sup>th</sup>) or Main Body Transportation Plan (for those travelling on June 19<sup>th</sup>). <a href="Please">Please</a> note that the time listed is the time the bus <a href="DEPARTS">DEPARTS</a> from that location! Please get there 30-60 minutes BEFORE the departure time (more when there are a lot of cadets boarding the bus).

I hope you're tracking on the **Packing List** – you should bring all the items on the list (except those mentioned as optional). Also consider getting a sleep mask and earplugs – some people have trouble sleeping in tents because of light or noise.

If for some reason, you have to **drop**, please email us at <u>encampment@cacadets.org</u> so we know your status. Refunds are only available for illness now that Covid test results aren't required for the bus.
