5. AB 1355 PASSES / CACC USE OF PARKS: This bill authorizes the Department of Parks and Recreation to waive all fees for the use, including camping where permitted, of any unit of the state park system by students of the California Cadet Corps or of a public military academy in exchange for completing a community service project at the unit that has been approved in advance by state park officials and staff of the California Cadet Corps or the academy, as applicable.

6. X-TREME TEAM CHALLENGE (XTC): Will be held on Saturday, 28 October 2017, at Los Alamitos Joint Forces Training Base. The Warning Order (WARNO) and all information pertaining to the XTC can be viewed at <https://cacadets.org/node/352>. Reminder that teams must consist of 10 Cadets (3 must be female). The deadline to register participates is 7 October 2017. Registration must be done online at <http://www.cadetstore.org/category-s/106.htm>.
7. COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (CERT): Will be held 17-19 November 2017 at Camp San Luis Obispo. For more information about the CERT Training refer to Circular 018-1718-001 at <https://cacadets.org/circulars>. This event is limited to 10 teams so register ASAP.
8. 2017 SUMMER ENCAMPMENT CHANGES: There are some tentative changes to the 2017 Summer Encampment. There will be two separate encampments, and possibly a third. The

unknown dates are for an Entrance Camp for Oakland Military Institute (OMI) and California Military Institute (CMI). The Leadership Encampment (Basic/BST, OCS, and NCO) will be scheduled 16-23 June with ADVON being 13-16 June. The Advanced Encampment (all the units usually in the Advanced Regiment) is going to be conducted in conjunction with BCTA/ACTA/CLS 13-20 July with ADVON being 10-13 July.
