- 5. COMMANDANTS CONFERENCE: Will be held on Saturday, 10 February 2018, at California Military Institute in Perris, CA. Uniform of the day is ACU/OCP/CMU. - 6. ANNUAL GENERAL INSPECTION (AGI): Due to budget constraints for this school year, each School will self-administer an AGI IAW CR 1-6 NLT 31 March 2018. Schools will conduct an AGI by completely filling out Appendix B from CR 1-6, have your Principal sign it, take a picture of your inranks inspection, and forward a PDF of the document and picture to agi@cadet.org. - 7. MARKSMANSHIP COMPETITION: will be held 24 February 2018 at Camp San Luis Obispo. The WARNO and information regarding RSVP can be viewed at https://cacadets.org/circulars.
- 2018 SUMMER ENCAMPMENT: This year there will be two Summer Encampments. The Leadership Encampment (Basic, NCO, and OCS) will be scheduled 16-23 June with ADVON being 13-16 June. The Advanced Encampment (all the units usually in the Advanced Regiment) will be conducted 13-20

July with ADVON being 10-13 July. Please check the website within the next few weeks as more information is finalized and published regarding this change.
