2. REVISED CR 1-6, CR 3-3, CR 3-4, AND CR 3-8: published to <https://cacadets.org/Regulations>. CR 1-6, Annual General Inspection, CR 3-3 Summer Encampment, CR 3-4, Individual Major Awards Program, and CR 3-8, Competitive Drill.
3. DRAFT REGULATIONS OUT FOR COMMENT: CR 3-17, Marksmanship Program, and CR 3-21.5, Drill and Ceremonies: open for commenting until 1 March 2019 and can be viewed at <https://cacadets.org/draftregulations>. Comments should be sent to LTC Smith at [michael.smith@cadet.org](mailto:michael.smith@cadet.org).
4. ANNUAL GENERAL INSPECTION (AGI): will be conducted during the months of February, March and April. Review the Circular for AGI inspection dates at <https://cacadets.org/circulars>. Also reference CR 1-6 for the AGI inspection rubric.
5. DRILL COMPETITION: will be held on Saturday, 13 April 2019, at Joint Forces Training Base Los Alamitos. View the Warning Order at <https://cacadets.org/circulars>. One change already is that lunches will be available for purchase (\$5 each). If schools want to pay for all their cadets with a check or credit card, email the Cadet Store at [cadetstore@cacadets.org](mailto:cadetstore@cacadets.org).
6. INDIVIDUAL MAJOR AWARDS COMPETITION: will be held 4 May 2019 at Camp San Luis Obispo. View the Warning Order at <https://cacadets.org/circulars>. Elementary schools are invited to send cadets to compete in this competition in their own category!
7. SUMMER ENCAMPMENTS: We've had a few glitches in planning our summer encampments, but we're working through them. Warning Orders should be posted by 6 FEB. Applications should open on the CACC website by 8 FEB. We may have to cap attendance at Leadership Camp, and possibly shuffle some courses around. Apply early to secure your slot! A Leadership course (BST, NCOA, OCS) remains a prerequisite to attend the Advanced Encampment. There are new Advanced Encampment courses available to middle school cadets this year - check out the Encampment website at <https://cacadets.org/Events/SummerEncampment>. It will be updated with 2019 information by 8 FEB!

8. NAMEPLATE MACHINE: HQCACC now has a nameplate-engraving machine to make nameplates for Cadets. Many Commandants have taken advantage of this great resource!   1. Only one nameplate per Cadet
  2. Last name only
  3. Names must be in ALL CAPS
  4. **Double check that all your Cadets' names are spelled CORRECTLY**
  5. Excel spreadsheet only.
    - a. One Cadet last name per row
    - b. No extra text on the spreadsheet
    - c. No notes
    - d. No non-name rows
    - e. No blank rows
  6. Email Excel spreadsheet as an attachment to [annerene.kelley@cadet.org](mailto:annerene.kelley@cadet.org).
    - a. Do not use Google docs
