  - 4. Double check that all your Cadets' names are spelled CORRECTLY
  - 5. Excel spreadsheet only.
    - a. One Cadet last name per row
    - b. No extra text on the spreadsheet
    - c. No notes
    - d. No non-name rows
    - e. No blank rows
  - 6. Email Excel spreadsheet as an attachment to <u>annerene.kelley@cacadets.org</u>.
    - a. Do not use Google docs
