2. AMERICAN RED CROSS FIRST AID, CPR, AED INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION COURSE: Congratulations to the 4 Commandants that completed the course held 15-16 November 2019 at Camp San Luis Obispo. The 9 Commandants are now certified to teach American Red Cross First Aid, CPR, and AED and other Red Cross Training.
3. COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (CERT) CERTIFICATION: Congratulations to the 10 Schools (50 Cadets) that completed the CERT Course held at Camp San Luis Obispo 15-17 November 2019. These 50 Cadets are now trained in CERT and are equipped with the necessary knowledge and skill to support and play key leadership roles in school emergency response operations during common campus emergencies.
