- 6. SUMMER ENCAMPMENT: is tentatively scheduled for 19-27 June 2021 with ADVON being 16-19 June 2021. There will be only one camp, with the first three days focused on leadership, the last six on advanced subjects. We tentatively plan to offer all Summer Encampment Units to include: BST, NCO Academy, OCS, Cyber, Drill and Ceremonies, Public Safety, Drill Instructor, Field Skills, Law Enforcement, Survival, Medic, Marksmanship, Mountaineering, and Leadership. <u>Cost will be \$150.00. A limited number of \$50 scholarships will be available.</u>

Summer Encampment application process is tentatively scheduled to begin on 1 March 2021 and end on 31 March 2021.

Go / No Go will depend on the COVID Pandemic situation and health policies statewide.
