Instructions Concerning Medications:

If your cadet routinely takes medications (prescription or over-the-counter), please send them in the package (bottle, etc.) provided by the pharmacy/store. Prescription meds should have the <u>name</u> and <u>dosage instructions</u> clearly labeled. Place the medications/instructions into a plastic ziplock bag, and give it to the bus supervisor for transport to SLO. One clearly marked bag per cadet, with the cadet's name on the bag. If a cadet takes multiple medications, place all of them in a single bag. Medications requiring refrigeration should be clearly identified. Our medical personnel will review the medications, and our adult supervisors will assist your cadet to ensure they take them when they're supposed to. Rescue medications that needs to stay with the cadet (i.e. an inhaler, epi-pen, etc.), please include a note that tells us to let the cadet keep the medication.
