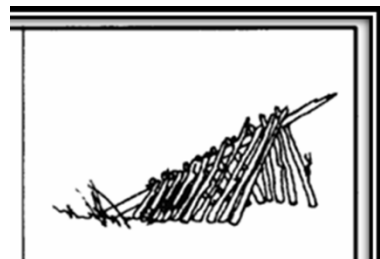
10. Match each fire building method and its advantage in the pictures below:

- dd. **Cross-Ditch:** Useful in open areas and/or in areas where very little breeze is blowing

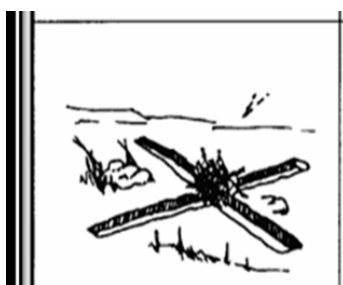
