MEMORANDUM FOR all California Cadet Corps personnel and units

SUBJECT: Change #2 to CR 1-8.

1. Effective immediately, Cadet Regulation 1-8, dated 1 December 2013 is amended as follows:
  - a. On page 10, Chapter 5, section 5-1(c), the wearout period for the Khaki Service Uniform is extended until further notice.
  - b. On page 24, Chapter 9, section 9-2(c)(2)(b), cadet rank shoulder marks may be worn on the Khaki Service Uniform.
  - c. On page 24, Chapter 9, section 9-2(b)(2), Blue as well as black shoulder ranks will remain authorized for cadets as long as they are serviceable and available.
  - d. On page 25, Chapter 9, section 9-4(b)(2)(b), Cadets who are ranked as Recruits can wear plain epaulets without shoulder marks.
  
2. Effective 21 January 2016 as described in LOI 010-1516-002, Cadet Regulation 1-8, dated 1 December 2013 is amended as follows:
  - a. On page 31, Chapter 9, section 9-10(c)(1), the CACC and unit patches are no longer to be affixed to the white uniform shirt. Patches are not to be removed from current shirts in circulation. Shirts with patches already affixed will be worn until they become unserviceable.
  - b. On page 31, Chapter 9, section 9-10(c)(1)(a), when a CACC patch is not worn on the white uniform shirt to identify program affiliation, the CACC Distinctive Unit Insignia (DUI) is to be worn 1/8 inch above and centered on the right pocket flap. The DUI will be worn 1/4 inch above unit awards.
  - c. On page 32, Chapter 9, section 9-11(c), when a unit patch is not worn on the white uniform shirt, units may purchase at their own cost pins that are replicas of their brigade patch to be worn in a similar manner as the Army's Combat Service Identification Badge described in DA PAM 670-1. That is centered between the bottom of the right pocket flap and the bottom of the pocket, and centered from left to right. Design of Brigade distinctive pins must be approved by HQS, CACC prior to ordering, production, or wear to ensure consistency of size and style throughout the corps.
