MEMORANDUM FOR All California Cadet Corps personnel and units

SUBJECT: Change #3 to CR 1-1, dated 15 June 2014.

- 1. Effective immediately, Cadet Regulation 1-1 is amended as follows:
 - a. Add 1-4i
 - b. Add 4-8
 - c. Add 4-9
 - d. Add 4-10
 - e. Add 4-11
- 1-4j. No more than four skill badges on the left may be worn at one time. The order of precedence for skill badges worn above the left pocket are as follows
 - (1) Cadet Medic Badge
 - (2) Mountaineering Badge
 - (3) Cyber Badge
 - (4) Law Enforcement Badge

4-8. The Cadet Drill Instructor Badge

- a. The Cadet Drill Instructor Badge may be awarded to cadets who successfully complete the Cadet Drill Instructor Course conducted by HQ, CACC. Brigades may receive permission to conduct their own Cadet Drill Instructor Course provided that the trainer is a certified Army Drill Sergeant or other DoD branch Drill Instructor, and provided that the instruction comes solely from the US Army TC 3-21.5.
- b. Cadets who are awarded the Cadet Drill Instructor Badge are authorized to wear the Army campaign hat while serving as an instructor at a Drill Academy where the Drill Academy Ribbon is awarded for successfully completing the course. The Army campaign hat is also authorized for wear while serving as an instructor or assistant instructor for HQ, CACC authorized Cadet Drill Instructor Course. The Army campaign hat is not authorized for wear on any other occasion. The hat will have a gold disc with the CACC DUI. The campaign hat is not provided by HQ, CACC and must be purchased by the cadet or cadet's unit.
- c. This badge shall consist of a gold metallic pin with a scroll at the bottom with the words "Cadet Drill Instructor" inscribed. There are three cadets wearing the traditional drill instructor campaign hat with each cadet offset and behind the other from right to left as worn by the wearer. A wreath surrounds the three cadets. This badge is issued by the HQ, CACC. Procurement and budget restraints may require slight deviations to this badge.
- d. This badge is to be worn on the Class A, B and C uniforms on the right pocket centered between the bottom edge of the pocket and the bottom edge of the pocket flap. When worn in conjunction with the Brigade Affiliation Insignia pin, it is to be worn to the left of it and both badges are centered on the pocket with $\frac{1}{2}$ space between the two.

4-9. The Mountaineering Badge

- a. The Mountaineering Badge may be awarded to cadets who successfully complete the Mountaineering Course conducted by HQ, CACC during annual encampment. This badge is issued by the HQ, CACC. Brigades are not authorized to conduct a mountaineering course where the Mountaineering Badge is awarded.
- b. This badge shall consist of a gold metallic pin in the shape of a shield with the word "Cadet" inscribed at the top. Underneath this is the frontal view of a male ram. Below the shield on a scroll is the word "Mountaineer". This badge is issued by the HQ, CACC. Procurement and budget restraints may require slight deviations to this badge.

c. This badge is to be worn on the Class A and B uniforms only and above all ribbons and bars in precedence with other skill badges found in para 1-4j of this regulation.

4-10. The Cyber Badge

- a. The Cyber Badge may be awarded to cadets who successfully complete the Cyber Course conducted by HQ, CACC. This badge is issued by the HQ, CACC.
- b. This badge shall consist of a metallic pin black in color surrounded by a thin gold outline. In the center are two gold, diagonally-crossed, lighting bolts with a gold sword that lays atop the lightning bolts vertically with the tip pointing to the top of the patch. The word "Cadet" is inscribed in white with a gold boarder above the lightning bolts and sword and the word "Cyber" inscribed in white with a gold border below. This badge is issued by the HQS CACC. Procurement and budget restraints may require slight deviations to this badge.
- c. This badge is to be worn on the Class A and B uniforms only and above all ribbons and bars in the precedence with other skill badge found in para 1-4j of this regulation.

4-11. The Law Enforcement Badge

- a. The Law Enforcement Badge may be awarded to cadets who successfully complete the Law Enforcement Course conducted by HQ, CACC.
- b. This badge shall consist of a circular metallic pin approximately 1½ in diameter. The badge consists of a gold trim with the words "Cadet Law Enforcement" inscribed in blue with "Cadet" at the top of the badge and "Law Enforcement" at the bottom. The center of the badge is a blue background with a gold, five-pointed, star and the CACC organizational DUI centered on the star. The CACC DUI fits within the body of the star. This badge is issued by the HQS CACC. Procurement and budget restraints may require slight deviations to this badge.
- c. This badge is to be worn on Class A and B uniforms only and above all ribbons and bars in the precedence with other skill badges found in para 1-4j of this regulation.
