1. SITUATION:

- a. Name of Event/Operation: Marksmanship Competition
- b. Dates: 24 February 2017 - 25 February 2017
- c. Start and End Times: 0800 - Teams should make initial plans to stay through Sunday. The number of teams will determine if the event will end on Saturday. After letters of intent have been received teams will be notified of the exact end date and time.
- d. Location: Camp San Luis Obispo
- e. Units Participating: All high school units eligible. The first 10 complete teams that have fulfilled the participation requirements will be accepted.
- f. Participation Requirements: Schools are eligible to bring two qualifying teams. Each team must consist of three members. Each team must also provide their own weapons. The weapons allowed are the following: .177 caliber pellet rifles, CO2 or pump is acceptable. Each team must provide their own CO2/air charging system. Rifles must comply with Civilian Marksmanship Program regulations. Each member of the team must also qualify under the Civilian Marksmanship Program.
- g. Training Events Planned: N/A

2. MISSION:

- a. The California Cadet Corps' Marksmanship Teams gather at Camp San Luis Obispo on 24 February 2017 to participate in a physically/mentally challenging marksmanship competition.

3. EXECUTION:

- a. Commander's Intent: A competitive event that provides the marksmanship team cadets an environment in which they establish a sense of unity among their respective teams, while remaining safe during the event, thus resulting in a building of character and gaining of marksmanship knowledge that could be passed on to our subordinate units out in the field that will aid in promoting Espirit de Corps.
- b. Concept of Operations: The Marksmanship Competition will focus on improving the skill set of cadets while creating a friendly, competitive environment.
- c. Goals:

- i. Goal 1 is to create a safe and competitive environment for the cadets to grow relations and build bonds through physically challenging activities with their respective teams.
 - ii. Goal 2 is to expand the marksmanship knowledge of cadets in order to prepare them to be successful leaders of their teams at their units.
 - iii. Goal 3 is to produce a fun atmosphere for the cadets to interact and build relations with other brigades in the California Cadet Corps.
 - d. Objectives:
 - i. 90% of cadet teams will complete the given challenges.
 - ii. No cadets are injured during the event.
 - iii. 100% of cadets will develop a sense of camaraderie within in their respective teams.
 - e. Cadet Leaders and Staff Assignments: The cadet staff and leaders for this event will be the 10th Corps Staff. Adult point of contact will be CW2 Shawn Carter (shawn.carter@cadet.org).
 - f. Application Process: Registration form see (Appendix A) must be submitted to SFC Dionne (dustin.dionne@cadet.org) and the Cadet S-1 (s1@cadet.org) NLT 22 December 2017.
 - g. Cost: There is no cost for this event.
 - h. Key Suspense Dates:
 - i. Intent Due: All cadet team's intent must be submitted NLT 22 December 2017.
 - ii. Rosters Due: All cadet team rosters are must be submitted NLT 22 December 2017.
 - iii. OPORD Published: 29 December 2017.
 - i. Uniform: All cadets must be in Physical Training gear. No boots will be worn at this event.
 - j. Awards: Awards given at this competition will be as follows:
 - i. 2 - 84 Competitive Rifle Team Ribbon
 - ii. 5 - 9 Competitive Rifle Team Shoulder Cord
 - iii. 2 - 35 LT Robert A. Clausen Marksmanship Award with the addition of the Gold Star (1st place), Silver Star (2nd place) or Bronze Star (3rd Place) attachment

4. SUSTAINMENT:

- a. Meals: Meals will be provided for this event.
- b. Cadet Store: The cadet store will not be open at this event.

- c. Transportation: All participating teams are responsible for their own transportation to and from Camp San Luis Obispo. All teams must arrive NLT Friday night, 23 February 2018.
- d. Billeting: Billeting will be provided. Participants are encouraged to bring bedding or sleeping bags.
- e. Commandants who wish to order separate billeting, must make arrangements through the billeting office at their own expense.
