### CALIFORNIA CADET CORPS PROMOTION EXAM TO CADET SERGEANT

You can find the CA Cadet Corps curriculum on the Cadet Corps website at <https://cacadets.org/Main>. Click on the Curriculum tab, then on Instructional Groups (you may have to go to this link twice, as the lessons often don't show up the first time you click on Instructional Groups, but they come up after that, divided into the four Subject Areas: Military Subjects, Citizenship, Leadership, and Wellness).

The exam for Cadet Sergeant covers curriculum areas that a cadet non-commissioned officer should know, from the lessons listed below. For example, in M1, the strand covering Cadet Regulations, there are questions from Section A (Core CACC Regulations). From M2 (Uniforms), there are questions from Sections A and B). Questions may be taken from all the lessons in the section. Some curriculum strands are not yet written. When they are added to the curriculum, test questions will be added in those areas.

The exam has 50 questions from a larger question bank, so no test is the same. The test is closed book – you may NOT use notes or curriculum material while you're taking the exam. You have a maximum of 50 minutes to take the exam. It is available on line by request through your Commandant; here's more information about it: <https://sway.office.com/mRBrQ8ce1FgPRQUL?ref=Link> You must attain a minimum score of 70% to pass the exam. If you need to retake it, you must wait two weeks.
